EVENT CHAIR



PROF. RICHARD SUSSKIND OBE

President, Society for Computers and Law

Professor Richard Susskind OBE is an author, speaker and independent adviser to international professional firms, general counsel, judiciaries, and national governments. His main area of expertise is the future of legal service, with particular reference to the impact of information technology. He has specialised in legal technology since the early 1980s and his views have influenced a generation of lawyers and legal technologists around the world.

He has written numerous books, including *Expert Systems in Law* (Oxford, 1987), *The Future of Law* (Oxford, 1996), *Transforming the Law* (Oxford, 2000), *The End of Lawyers?* (Oxford 2008), *Tomorrow's Lawyers* (Oxford, 2013), and (co-author, Daniel Susskind) *The Future of the Professions* (Oxford, 2015).

Richard is President of the Society for Computers and Law and, since 1998, he has been IT Adviser to the Lord Chief Justice of England and Wales. From 2003 until 2008, he was Chair of the UK's Advisory Panel on Public Sector Information (a non-departmental public body set up by the Cabinet Office in 2003, and now part of the Ministry of Justice). He is Chair of the Advisory Board, and Visiting Professor in Internet Studies, at the Oxford Internet Institute in the University of Oxford. Richard is also Chair of the Online Dispute Resolution Group of the Civil Justice Council of England and Wales, Special Adviser to the Canadian Bar Association, and IT Adviser to the Jersey Legal Information Board.

Richard is an Honorary Professor at the Law School in University College London, Emeritus Law Professor at Gresham College in London, and a part-time law professor at the University of Strathclyde in Glasgow.



EVENT CHAIRMAN 2019

Richard has a first class honours degree in law from Glasgow University and a doctorate in law and computers from Balliol College, Oxford. He is a Fellow of the British Computer Society and a Fellow of the Royal Society of Edinburgh. He was awarded an OBE in the Millennium New Year's Honours List by Her Majesty the Queen for services to IT in the Law and to the Administration of Justice.

PRANAV MISTRY

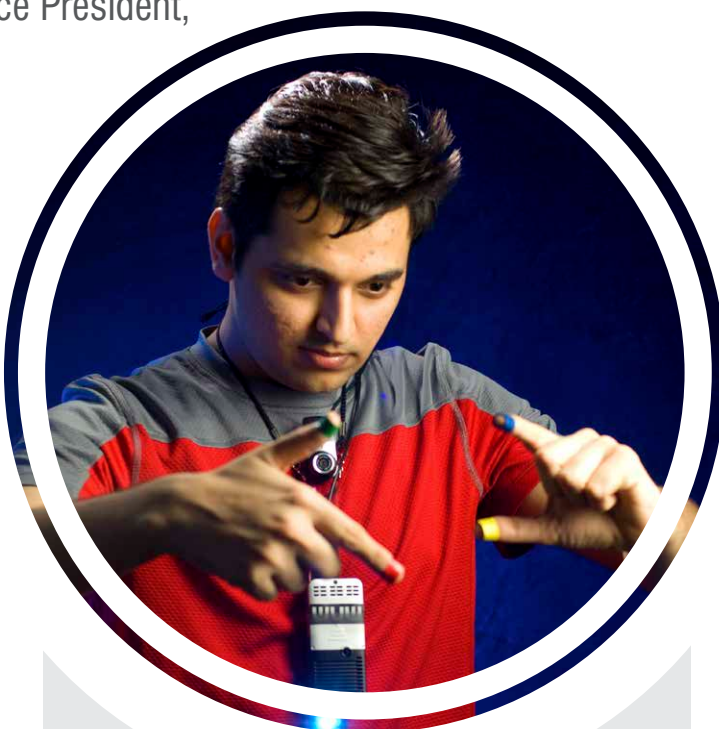

Pranav Mistry is a renowned scientist and inventor. Pranav's contribution to the fields such as Wearable Computing, Augmented Reality and Gestural Computing puts him in the elite list of pioneers and inventors that shape the future of digital world.

Inventor, Designer and Engineer from heart, Pranav Mistry is best known for his inventions of SixthSense and Samsung Gear. In 2009, Pranav introduced SixthSense – wearable gestural computing technology to the world during TED2009 talk. Since then, Pranav is one of the most watched TED speaker (more than 20 million views). Amongst some of his other work, Pranav has invented Mouseless – an invisible computer mouse; SPARSH– a novel way to copy-paste data between digital devices; Quickies – intelligent sticky notes that can be searched, located and can send reminders and messages; Blinkbot – a gaze and blink controlled robot; a pen that can draw in 3D; and a public map that can act as the Google of the physical world and many more. Pranav holds several patents and has published many research papers in various academic conferences.

In September 2013, Pranav introduced Samsung Gear smartwatch during the IFA in Germany. Samsung Gear is considered the pioneer in wearable computing devices. Pranav's research field include Wearable Computing, Augmented Reality, Ubiquitous Computing, Gestural Interaction, Artificial Intelligence, Machine Vision, Collective Intelligence and Robotics.

Pranav has been part of organizations such as MIT, IIT Bombay, CMU, NASA, UNESCO, Google, Microsoft, Japan Science and Technology, to name a few. At present, Pranav serves as the head of Think Tank Team and Global Senior Vice President at Samsung, one of the world leaders in consumer electronics companies. In his current role he is leading research and development of Samsung's future products. Besides his role at Samsung, Pranav also serves as an advisor to several Indian and International technology companies.
